Please find attached a Notice of Liability addressed to your institution, dated April 20, A.D. 2026. The Notice takes effect immediately upon transmission.

Each recipient law society receives an individualized Notice specific to its jurisdiction. The Barreau du Québec receives both English and French copies.

The Notice concerns the knowing permission of licensee participation in ongoing breach of trust and extraction from the pre-existing liberties of the Heirs, as described in the attached document. It establishes a daily accumulating fine, prorated to the hour, against each institution and against any licensee who participates in the conduct described therein after receipt.

The constitutional record, the criminal record, and the fee schedule are set out in the attached Notice. Service is effected upon transmission. The mail server timestamp is the authoritative record.

Please note: Neither Alberta nor Saskatchewan appear to publish an email address. We leave their correspondence in your care.
